## ALL OF THE ABOVE

I recently read an article by a fellow youth worker entitled "You Have a Youth Ministry" by Brooklyn Lindsey. I really liked what she had to say, so I wanted to share some of her thoughts with you. Brooklyn describes how her family was placed in a position of starting a new church in their community when she had previously been involved in full time youth ministry. In the midst of this transition, God was teaching her a valuable lesson. She recalls, "For the first two months I told people, 'we don't have a youth ministry.' Everything was so overwhelming. Everything was so new. There were countless decisions, meetings, discussions. I am still in shock that it all happened so quickly. This is why I couldn't imagine starting up a youth program in the middle of it all. It was during this exact season when everything I've learned and all that I think God has been trying to teach me boomeranged back to upset the youth ministry equilibrium I had grown so comfortable in. I almost think I needed the chaos to be able to find the simple truth...**This idea emerged that youth ministry happens in your everyday life shared together.**" She could feel God urging her saying, "You have a youth ministry.' 'Brooklyn, you have a youth ministry'. 'Every person who lives has a youth ministry.' The difference between those who have one and those who don't is whether or not they choose it."

There are thousands of teens in the community of Winchester, and it's easy to convince ourselves that someone else is showing them love. They have teachers, friends, and parents, someone else will handle it. Teenagers can be intimidating and unpredictable after all. But what if the person they need in their life is really you? I think we have to be in tune to God's urges on our lives, to be able to recognize them and follow His will, no matter how small or seemingly insignificant the act. Brooklyn continues, "For me, to say, 'I don't have a youth ministry' was ludicrous. It was a way out when I didn't know the way in. It was an excuse because we weren't going to have all of the hype anymore. But thank God the hype died long enough for me to see it. The hype is just the vitamin. Your relationships are the meal..."

**There is a ministry outside of the walls of the church where teenagers live, where we find our best opportunity to love and walk with kids in their needs. I hope this is the heart of every person who feels called to love teenagers:**

*Love the kid in front of you.*

*Even when it's hard. Even when you have to go out of your way to find out what's up in their world. Even if you don't have a budget or a "thing" to draw them to. Find one to love...don't wait for them to come to you.*

*Because that kid, that person who was lucky enough to be loved by you, will thank you someday--for not waiting for things to be perfect--but saying yes to whatever is happening now."*
