# Moore Musings

The month of July is a time of great celebration for us Americans. On July 4<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate our nation's birth. This year marks 241 years since we began as a country with our Declaration of Independence. It took great courage and unity for our founding fathers to declare independence from Great Britain. However, some 85 years later our unity had disappeared, and we were at war with one another. Even though our nation survived a civil war and went on to prosper, still today there is great anger in our nation toward each other. We are angry at each other over economic issues, political issues, race issues, control issues, and religious issues. Our anger is seen in the news, on the internet, in our work places, in our communities, and in our churches. The level of anger seems out of control with no end in sight. So what are we to do? Since trying to control someone else's anger seems foolish, perhaps we should focus on controlling our own anger. During July, my sermon series will address our anger management by looking at the biblical understanding of anger, the sources of our anger, how God handles his anger, and how we should handle our anger.
